For this bid to be accepted as complete, all pages must be completed and returned by the specified date and time.

All proposals must be submitted in opaque sealed envelopes, on County Road Commission bid forms, and labeled as a sealed bid, along with the nature of the bid specified on the envelope.

SPECIFICATIONS FOR BID

Bid will be for painting ceiling, part of walls and beams. Bidder will be required to cover heating units, fire alarm sensors and electrical panels. Loose dust has been blown off surfaces and beams power washed. Bidder will be required to apply latex base primer Sherwin Williams PRO-BLOCK or approved equal to all surfaces. Bidder will apply 1 coat water-base dryfall bright white satin finish to ceilings and beams. Bidder will apply 1 coat of pre-catalyzed water-base epoxy bright white to walls and vertical beams. All work will be done during Iosco County Road Commission normal working hours. Painting will be as per manufacturer recommended procedures and best trade practices. Inspection of building by appointment before bidding required. Bidder will furnish copy of insurance stated below.

INSURANCE REQUIREMENTS FOR IOSCO COUNTY ROAD COMMISSION

1. The permittee or contractor shall name as **additional insured parties** on any general comprehensive liability insurance or commercial general liability insurance carried by the permittee or contractor **(the following must read exact):**

“The Board of Iosco County Road Commissioners, the Iosco County Road Commission, and their officers, agents and employees, are named as additional insured.”

2. Such insurance shall consist of:

a. **Insurance specifications:** Comprehensive General Liability, including coverage for contractual liability, completed operations, and/or product liability X, C and U, and contractor’s protective liability with a blasting endorsement when blasting is involved, or Commercial General Liability which includes all the above.

b. **Amounts:**

(1) Comprehensive General Liability:

Bodily Injury -- \$500,000 each occurrence
\$500,000 aggregate

Property Damage - \$250,000 each occurrence
\$250,000 aggregate

(2) Commercial General Liability insurance limits shall be \$500,000 each occurrence and aggregate.

3. NO WORK IS TO BE PERFORMED WITHOUT THE ABOVE POLICIES BEING CURRENTLY IN EFFECT.

4. Should the policy be cancelled or expire all activities authorized by the contract shall cease and the authority to continue operating is deemed of no effect pending reinstatement of such policy in conformity with the above.

5. Proof of insurance shall be the certificate of insurance, or should the department elect, a copy of the policy or both .
