Job Title	Skilled Mechanic, Full Time (40 hours per week)

Job Description:

- Repairing or replacing parts on equipment and vehicles
- Making mechanical and electrical adjustments on a wide range of motors and mechanical equipment
- Welding, wiring, transmission overhauls, hydraulics
- Installation of special equipment
- General maintenance/repair of all equipment used by road commission personnel

Job Requirements:

- High school diploma
- Current Michigan Auto Brake and Truck Brake certification.
- Ability to weld and use oxygen/acetylene cutting torches.

Special Requirements:

- 2 years heavy duty and small vehicle mechanical experience preferred.
- A valid CDL, Group A, with "T" endorsement along with a medical examiner's certificate is desirable. CDL training is available to qualified applicants.
- An excellent driving record.
- Applicants must take and pass drug screening and a physical examination and undergo a reference and security check.
- Physical ability (strength, vision, manual dexterity, general good health and physical condition) to perform assigned tasks.
- Applicants must be able to work extended hours, nights, weekends and holidays, when necessary.
